## **Exco operating company relocates headquarters operation to NACOGDOCHES COUNTY**

**NACOGDOCHES, Texas** (August 10, 2011) — Exco Operating Company celebrated the grand opening of its \$2.5 million Shelby Field headquarters office in Chireno to support Haynesville Shale operations in East Texas.

Exco's Chireno operation will employ approximately 60 Exco employees, along with roughly 30 contract employees, at salaries well above the current average salary for Nacogdoches County. This is in addition to well over 100 Exco employees located at drilling sites throughout Nacogdoches and San Augustine Counties. The Nacogdoches County Commissioners' Court, along with NEDCO, have been working closely with Exco since late last year.

The facility is located on a 40-acre site is located at the intersection of Hwy 21 and Hwy 95, in Chireno, about 15 miles east of the City of Nacogdoches. Construction activity began in October 2010, and continued through mid-2011.

Exco is located on property adjacent to Select Energy Services, which provides oilfield services logistics support to Exco.
